


SEND Transfers

Transfers OUT: Discharge from the SEND system immediately at transfer.

Transfers IN: Before admitting a transferred patient into SEND check if the referring hospital is using SEND.

If the referring hospital DOES use SEND then you must only admit the patient to the SEND system in your hospital when the patient appears in 'unit transfers'.
